TRANSPORTATION

Teams are expected to arrive at Baiyun Airport in Guangzhou between the morning and afternoon of that Friday. NCPA will provide shuttles from Baiyun Airport to the Nansha Grand Hotel with an NCPA representative to welcome you and ensure that transfers to the hotel run smoothly.

TOURNAMENT FEE

The tournament fee **DOES NOT** include travel cost to Baiyun Airport nor hotel cost in Nansha.
